The Basic CISM training program is designed to present the core elements of a comprehensive, systematic, and multi-component crisis intervention curriculum. Emergency services personnel, disaster workers, first responders; professionals in mental health, the medical field, education, employee assistance programs (EAPs), and human resources are all encouraged to attend.

Mike Haley, CTR was a police officer for 26 years before retiring as Chief of Police for the Clinton Township. He is currently the Chairperson of the National Fraternal Order of Police, Critical Incident Program and the Director of the Fraternal Order of Police of Ohio's Critical Incident Response Service, which he has chaired since 1996. He is the founder of the Mid-Ohio Critical Incident Stress Management Team, which serves law enforcement in the Columbus, Ohio metropolitan area. Mike responded, on multiple occasions, to the World Trade Center disaster as part of a law enforcement CISM response. He also provided CISM services to the NOPD during the aftermath of hurricane Katrina. He is also certified by the Association of Traumatic Stress Specialist.
